BRICK STORE MUSEUM HOSTS ANCESTORS ROAD SHOW

KENNEBUNK, Maine – If you are the family genealogist, stuck trying to find records, need help analyzing an old document or are simply interested in writing up your family history but don't know where to begin, then the Ancestors Road Show is for you. On Saturday, August 14, from 10AM to 1PM, the Brick Store Museum at 117 Main Street, Kennebunk, is hosting an Ancestors Road Show for researchers of all ages. Attendees will have an opportunity to book 25-minute, one-on-one sessions with skilled genealogists—all members of the New England Chapter of the Association of Professional Genealogists—to personally assist with genealogy “roadblocks.” Margaret Dube, Pam Stone Eagleson, and Carol McCoy have years of experience and expertise that can provide answers and new perspectives.

Consultations are \$25 for a 25-minute session and \$20 for current museum members. Drop-ins are welcome, but pre-scheduling is highly encouraged by contacting the museum at 207-985-4802. To get the most out of a consultation, participants are advised to email in advance or come prepared with a brief description of the research topic to be addressed, including information such as research goals and locales, relevant names and relationships, and the time period involved.
