BRICK STORE MUSEUM CALLS FOR ARTWORK FOR *EXPRESSIONS OF THE HEART* EXHIBITION

KENNEBUNK – Following on the heels of last winter’s successful art exhibition, *Between Autumn and Spring*, The Brick Store Museum is pleased to announce its plan to mount its second annual exhibition of celebrated local wall art in its premier exhibition space. The title and theme for the 2005 exhibition is *Expressions of the Heart*, to coincide with the exhibition’s opening near Valentine’s Day. The exhibition continues a Brick Store Museum tradition of exhibiting artwork by the region’s artists.

Expressions of the Heart will be on public view from February 15 through April 1, 2005 and will feature local wall artists’ interpretations of the exhibition’s theme. As a juried exhibition, the Museum requires the following for artwork to be considered:

- Work must be original wall art by the submitting artist—preferably from York County, Maine—and clearly reflect the exhibition’s theme of *Expressions of the Heart*.
- Works should be recent, i.e. after January 1, 2004.
- Size per piece should not exceed 8 square feet.
- Two 3” x 5” or 4” x 6” color photos or two slides (marked with the artist’s contact information), accompanied by a self-addressed, stamped envelope are to be delivered by hand or post by close of business on **January 11, 2005**, to: The Brick Store Museum, 117 Main Street, Kennebunk, ME 04043.

The Brick Store Museum is located in Kennebunk, Maine’s historic district and is dedicated to preserving and exhibiting the region’s rich cultural and artistic heritage.
