You're going to be a history sleuth! You'll be presented with a case filled with materials culled from the Brick Store Museum's extensive collections. Working with others on your "detective squad," you'll hone your investigative skills and use your powers of deduction. Sift through clues from artifacts, historical documents and photographs across the centuries to piece together the background of an actual person or place from Kennebunk's past. Who or what will it be?

Your squad will have a chance to creatively reveal its findings, perhaps as a news broadcast, mini-documentary, or historical reenactment. Whatever format you choose, your squad's presentation will be professionally videotaped and recorded to a DVD for you to keep as proof of your fine detective work!
