Physical Description:

This collection was given to the Museum by the owners of the Captain Nathaniel Lord Mansion, Rick Litchfield and Bev Davis. The donors have created a world-class bed and breakfast inn in the great house. The materials in this collection were put together during years of doing business in the house. They include brochures, newsletters, awards for excellence, and publications featuring the house.

The collection also includes materials relevant to Kennebunkport's famous Christmas Prelude. Rick Litchfield helped conceive and organize the event. Planning materials, publicity items, and some photographs are included here.

This is a collection that may grow as more donations are made, but as of this writing, it is stored in two boxes (one flat). The collection's accession number is 1993-21.
