Physical Description:

This collection of archival materials is from the Downing family, and includes miscellaneous papers and other items dating from 1805 to 1885.

This collection was donated by John Downing of Kennebunk in December 1997. An inventory listing was done at that time and accession numbers assigned to each object. The collection numbered 48 archival objects, 1997.35.1-48, and 15 additional archival items, apparently unnumbered. At this time, items .1-.24, and .44-.48 have been found and catalogued. The remaining items will be added to the collection when found. The original listing completed in 1997 with accession numbers is in the donor file.
