Physical Description:

This collection represents papers of George Harmond of Scarborough and Pepperelborough (Saco). It consists of 26 pieces, mostly receipts. Included are a tax receipt from Edward S. Mouton, Collector in Saco, to Zachariah Harmon; a tax receipt to George Harmon from the town of Wayne, 1815; a bill from John S. Williams, Physician, to William Thomas and Martha Viny for care of William Gardiner, 1779; a request from heirs of Samuel and Sarah Foss for payment of legacy left by her father, George Harmon, 1835; assorted papers of Zachariah Harmon; and two tickets, one for freight on "Pontchartrain Railroad," no date.
