Physical Description:

This small collection is made up of a series of certificates issued from 1928 – 1953 to Donald Chamberlin from the Maine Department of Agriculture, authorizing the sale of milk and cream. Also included is a Sanitary Inspection Report, 1942, from the Maine Bureau of Health.

Chamberlin, who operated an “automobile service”, also sold ice cream in a store on upper Main Street. The certificates were found in the Brick Store Museum’s Barry Workshop building, which was purchased from the Chamberlin estate in 1958. The papers were in a make-shift pocket made from the cover of a cigar box to which was tacked a piece of clear plastic. This was probably mounted where it could be seen by customers, proof of Chamberlin’s certification as a dealer in ice cream.

The collection is in one folder. It was acquisition #3222.
