Physical Description:

This small collection includes photographs and a few documents relating to Captain William Gould of Kennebunkport and his son-in-law Robert Tapley, who married Gould's daughter, Agnes. Many of the photographs are of vessels sailed by Gould and Tapley. Of local interest is the Savannah, built in 1901 by David Clark of Kennebunkport.

The documents include two letters, one of which (and perhaps both) to Agnes M. I. (Gould) Tapley. Also a small notebook of expenses, etc., that was probably kept by Mrs. Tapley. It is not dated.

The collection is in two folders (the documents in Folder #1, the photographs in Folder #2*). Its acquisition number is 82.42.2.
