Physical Description:

This small collection of materials pertaining to the Kenneth H. Grant family of Kennebunk was given to the Brick Store Museum by the attorney settling the estate of Kenneth Grant, son of Raymond H. Grant, who died in 1986. The material dates from the 1840s and 1850s and includes some genealogical information. See the folder listings for a more complete description. A number of photographs have been put with the photograph collection by number. See the Grant Family folder and the acquisition card file for more information.

Folder Breakdown:

- Folder 1: Pages from a family Bible and other genealogical information on the ancestry of Raymond Hartwell Grant.
- Folder 2: Miscellaneous correspondence and business papers, mostly of Raymond H. Grant, 1942 – 1958. Includes Grant's estimates and invoices for work done on "Cousins" [Cousens] School, 1958.
- Folder 3: Rationing stamps and related materials, World War II.
- Folder 4: Ration books of Grant family members, World War II.

This collection also includes a "Plan for a Proposed Alteration" to the road at Lord's Point, Kennebunk Beach, 1913, which is stored in Folio Box #2, Folder 3. Also, diploma of Kenneth R. Grant, Kennebunk Grammar School, 1935. Misc. Box (0) #4, Folder 1
