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Physical Description:

Research needs to be done to determine the roles and relationships of the various keepers of the account books in this collection. Loose papers removed to Folder 1 from the various ledgers seem to indicate that Joseph A. Goodwin was an official (perhaps selectman) of the Town of Wells. Howard Littlefield, also of Wells, was evidently a Representative to the Legislature, State of Maine.
