BRICK STORE MUSEUM OFFERS *FROZEN FEBRUARY FUN* WORKSHOP FOR KIDS

KENNEBUNK – To coincide with the school system’s winter vacation, The Brick Store Museum is pleased to offer “Frozen February Fun,” a one-day workshop from 10 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 23, for children ages 8 to 12. (Snow date: February 24.)

All participants will complete three interactive, indoor projects reminiscent of activities that youngsters from yesteryear would have done during the winter months. Children will construct pierced tin lanterns, make and frame silhouette portraits of themselves and create keepsake scrapbooks. Children will also have a special, behind-the-scenes look at antique winter toys and apparel from the museum’s collections.

The workshop concludes with a public viewing of the children’s projects in the Museum from 2:30 to 3:00 p.m. and a chance to tour the Museum’s current exhibitions. “Frozen February Fun” is made possible by The Brick Store Museum’s Education Committee.
