The Brick Store Museum invites you to get up and garden with its Annual Geranium Sale on Saturday, May 14, 2005, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. at historic Wallingford Farm, located at 21 York Street (Route 1 South) in Kennebunk. The rain date is Sunday, May 15.

Wallingford Farm is once again partnering with the Museum to generously host this one-day event. The colorful red, coral, pink and white geranium blossoms are long-lasting and perfect for enhancing window boxes, planters and hanging baskets at home or work.

Four-inch pots are priced at \$4 each (3 for \$10), and six-inch pots are \$8 each (2 for \$15). Also on sale for \$6 will be bags of quality plant mix graciously donated by Winterwood Farm®. Museum merchandise and homemade baked goods and crafts will be available from museum volunteers. All proceeds from the day's sales directly benefit the public programs and activities of The Brick Store Museum.

Throughout the day, gardeners and a representative from Winterwood Farm® will be on hand to answer questions and share container gardening tips. Wallingford Farm will additionally be offering its full array of products, plants and gardening supplies. Novices and experienced gardeners alike will enjoy preparing their spring gardens for Memorial Day weekend, all while supporting The Brick Store Museum.
