**BRICK STORE MUSEUM INVITES SPONSORS AND GOLFERS FOR
10th ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT AND DINNER**

KENNEBUNK – Spring is finally here, and with it comes The Brick Store Museum’s 10th annual golf tournament and dinner to be held Monday, June 4, 2007, on Webhannet Golf Club’s beautifully manicured greens at Kennebunk Beach. In among the first golf events of the season, share in the legendary camaraderie of the Museum’s largest annual fundraising event. Last year’s tournament generated more than \$12,000, with the proceeds benefiting the Museum’s exhibitions, educational outreach activities and preservation initiatives.

The tournament is in a scramble format with a 1 PM shotgun start. This fun-filled afternoon showcases 18 holes sponsored by community-minded businesses, a social hour, and a silent auction and raffle—all capped off by dinner catered by The Kitchen Chicks. Golfer contests and prizes abound in a variety of categories, and there is a chance to win a car with a hole-in-one contest sponsored by Dick Mariano Chrysler and Morris Insurance Services. Golfer registration of \$115 per player includes greens fees, golf cart, on-course refreshments, goodie bag, and the post-tournament social hour and catered dinner. Players may enter individually or as a foursome. Dinner tickets for non-golfers are available at \$25 apiece.

The raffle and silent auction feature highly desirable items, including original artwork, home goods, and gift certificates for local restaurants and businesses. Raffle tickets are 5 for \$5 and 25 for \$20. The raffle drawing will be held in conjunction with the post-tournament dinner on June 4, but one does not need to be present to win.
