**MUSEUM'S 10th ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT AND DINNER
RESCHEDULED DUE TO RAINOUT**

KENNEBUNK – The Brick Store Museum's 10th annual golf tournament originally slated for June 4 was rained out. Fortunately, the tournament has been rescheduled for Monday, September 17, 2007, at Webhannet Golf Club at Kennebunk Beach. A social hour and tournament dinner will follow, complete with golfer prizes and a fantastic raffle and silent auction featuring all the original sponsors and donors. Previously registered teams are asked to please reconfirm their attendance for the new date no later than September 7, and any additional players or teams are welcome. Proceeds from the tournament benefit the Museum's exhibitions, educational outreach activities and preservation initiatives. The tournament is in a scramble format with a 1 PM shotgun start. This fun-filled afternoon showcases 18 holes sponsored by community-minded businesses. Golfer contests and prizes abound in a variety of categories, and there is a chance to win a car with a hole-in-one contest sponsored by Dick Mariano Chrysler and Morris Insurance Services. Golfer registration of \$115 per player includes greens fees, golf cart, on-course refreshments, goodie bag, post-tournament social hour, and dinner catered by The Kitchen Chicks. Players may enter individually or as a foursome. Dinner tickets for non-golfers are available at \$25 apiece.

The raffle and silent auction feature highly desirable items, including original artwork, home goods, sports memorabilia, and gift certificates for local restaurants and businesses. Raffle tickets are 6 for \$5 and 25 for \$20. The raffle drawing will be held in conjunction with the post-tournament dinner on September 17 but one does not need to be present to win.

The Brick Store Museum is located at 117 Main Street in Kennebunk's historic district and for more than seventy years has been dedicated to preserving and exhibiting the region's rich cultural heritage. Its galleries and research archives are open to the public year-round: Tuesdays through Fridays, 10 – 4:30 and Saturdays, 10 – 1. Admission to the Museum is by donation, suggested \$5 per person.
