LIVING little: The MINI Series

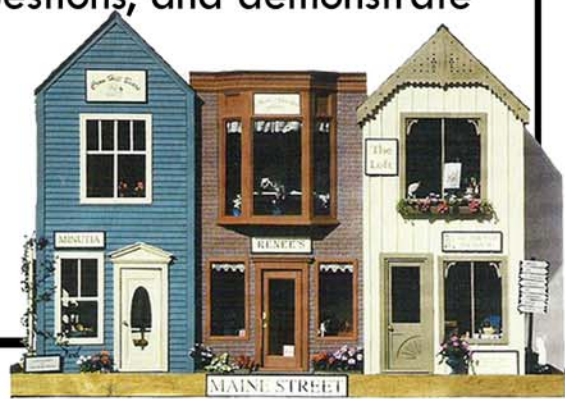
117 Main Street Kennebunk
