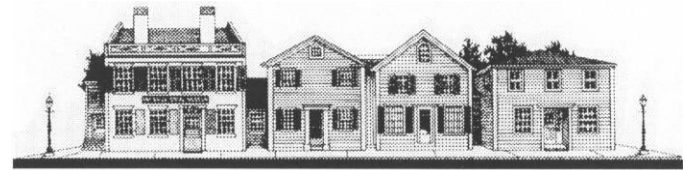

Each of the day's activities ties in with the Museum's current and upcoming exhibitions this season, including: *Salon Style: Fine Art from the 1830s to the 1920s*, *Quilts from the Collections of the Brick Store Museum*, and *Celebrating 35 Years of Kennebunk's National Register Historic District*.

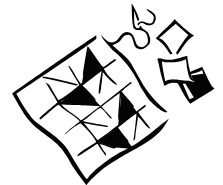
You'll begin the morning with a quick trip through each of the displays to serve as your inspiration. You'll then dive right into the world of early American portraiture, learn about itinerant painters and their unique techniques, and even use some 21st-century technology to fashion yourself for a 19th-century portrait sitting!



Next up is a walk through a section of Kennebunk's historic district—the very first in Maine!—and a chance to see the various elements and styles that make this district so special. You'll then have an opportunity to re-create one of these ornate homes as an architectural model, complete with a write-up of its storied past!



Then, it's time to let your creativity shine by designing and piecing a quilt square based upon the amazing patterns found on quilted masterpieces in the Museum's collections. No sewing required! What will yours be?
