**BRICK STORE MUSEUM HOSTS FREE FAMILY
PORTRAIT SESSION AS TIE-IN WITH PHOTO EXHIBIT**

KENNEBUNK, MAINE – As a special tie-in with the ongoing popular exhibition, *Faces of the Kennebunks by Portrait Photographer Liam Crotty*, The Brick Store Museum is hosting complimentary family portrait sessions. For one day only—Saturday, March 29 between 10AM and 1PM—the exhibition’s featured photographer Liam Crotty is offering a free family portrait sitting at the Museum and one free 8 x 10 color photo, a package that would normally carry more than a \$125 value. Additional prints may be ordered for a fee, with a portion of the proceeds coming back to the Museum as a donation. Please call ahead to the Museum at 207.985.4802 to reserve a time slot in advance. Space is limited, so portrait reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis. Sorry, no pets, please.

On view through May 3, *Faces of the Kennebunks* and its related programming are sponsored by Kennebunk Savings Bank, with additional exhibition support provided by the Museum’s proud business partner, The Captain Lord Mansion. The exhibition invites audiences to look through the lens of this accomplished local portrait photographer to see the diversity and depth of character and talent found in the Kennebunks. Twenty-three large-format, color and black-and-white images touch upon the contemporary fabric of the community—whether it’s a Main Street businessman, retired sea captain, or extreme-weather surfer. Further enhancing the portraits are artifacts on loan from those photographed, adding three-dimensional components to the portrait groupings.
