BRICK STORE MUSEUM WELCOMES LIVE CONCERT BY “TWO OLD FRIENDS”

KENNEBUNK, MAINE – Fishtraks recording artists Two Old Friends will be performing live on Sunday, October 19, at 2PM in The Brick Store Museum’s Program Center at 4 Dane Street, Kennebunk. Mac McHale and Emery Hutchins have given hundreds of concerts over the years, but this represents their first at the museum venue, where they will delight audiences young and old with their music from Ireland, the mountains and the sea. With banjo, guitar, mandolin, concertina, bodran, octave mandolin, and heart-warming vocals, Two Old Friends demonstrate how immigrants arrived in America from Ireland, Scotland and Great Britain and brought their melodies and instruments along with them. They show how many old-time country songs in Appalachia derive from these timeless tunes. Audiences are treated to plaintive ballads, foot-stomping shout tunes, soaring mandolin solos, sing-alongs and more as part of this rousing performance not to be missed.
