**BRICK STORE MUSEUM OFFERS ESCORTED TRIP
TO VIRGINIA'S HISTORIC TRIANGLE**

KENNEBUNK, MAINE – The Brick Store Museum is pleased to announce that it is offering to the general public a special, escorted cultural excursion to Virginia's historic triangle—Colonial Williamsburg, Jamestown and Yorktown—from April 29 through May 3, 2007.

The spring tour coincides with a national celebration of the 400th anniversary of the founding of the first permanent English settlement in the Americas at Jamestown. Eighteen months of festivities and events are focusing on Jamestown's legacies and are even being attended by Queen Elizabeth II and his Royal Highness Prince Philip.

For only \$1299 per person, based upon double occupancy, this special excursion includes round-trip airfare on Airtran Airways (Boston-Newport News), transportation to and from Logan Airport, charter bus transfers, four nights at Colonial Williamsburg's Woodland Hotel & Suites, daily continental breakfast, three singular dining experiences, and historic area admissions to Colonial Williamsburg, Jamestown Settlement, Historic Jamestowne, Yorktown Victory Center, Yorktown Battlefield and two scenic James River plantations. Daily itineraries are varied and range from specially-guided tours and witnessing living history to strolling the historic district amid Virginia's springtime blossoms. This trip is limited to 20 participants, with final payments due by March 16.
