



## Season of Giving Arts Sale

### CALL FOR ENTRIES

Saturdays & Sundays: December 2-3, 9-10, 16-17

At the Brick Store Museum Program Center

#### **What is it?**

The Season of Giving Arts Sale invites artists, crafters, and makers of all media and categories to submit your items to this holiday arts sale.

This event is not intended as a “booth show,” but a display of local art and craft that will be designed more like a retail pop-up store. The Museum is dedicated to highlighting local arts and entrepreneurs, and offer this outlet to artisans without brick-and-mortar stores to reach customers during the holiday season. *This call is open to artists, crafters, collectors, and makers who create artwork, three-dimensional items, unique clothing, food, soaps, and other locally-crafted items.*

#### **When is it?**

The Season of Giving Arts Sale will take place over three weekends in December. The weekends (Saturday – Sunday) are: December 2 & 3, December 9 & 10, and December 16 & 17, with the following times:

Saturdays: 10:00am – 4:00pm

Sundays: 12:00pm – 4:00pm

\* The Arts Sale will also be open on Friday, December 8<sup>th</sup> from 5:00pm - 7:00pm as part of the Art Trail of the Kennebunks event.

## How Does it Work?

- Submissions will be juried. Artists are invited to submit an application (next page) to the Arts Sale by September 30<sup>th</sup>. Artists will be notified by October 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Items will be displayed on tables in the Museum's Program Center, categorized by artist, but displayed together with all submissions. You are welcome to drop off a specialized display rack or pedestal, which will be used at the discretion of Museum staff when setting up the show. The Program Center is locked and alarmed when the Arts Sale is not operating.
- Artists will be asked to drop off their items at the Museum by Friday, November 17<sup>th</sup>. Each artist will sign a Loan-In Form to acknowledge the Museum's receipt of each item (please bring an inventory list with you, including prices). We'll also ask you for a short bio and artist statement to display in the Sale next to your pieces.
- There is no fee to participate in the show! The Brick Store Museum will ask for a 30% commission on artists' total sales for the three weekends. Sales will be processed through the Museum's cash register, and Museum staff will track the sales for each artist. Artists will be mailed checks by December 22, 2017. Payments will represent the artists' total commission, minus Brick Store Museum commission and sales tax (paid by the Brick Store Museum).
- At the end of the sale, artists will be asked to pick up any unsold items.
